

MT. MISERY TRIP DEPARTURE INFORMATION

Are you excited yet? We certainly are and the kids are starting to get a tad anxious. We're going to have good weather and a great deal of fun. Here are some last-minute directions that will answer some of your questions and make the morning drop-off go a little smoother.

- Students are expected to be at school between **8:45 and 9:00 a.m. Tuesday morning**. Please understand students will need to be dropped off or car pool to school that day. Students cannot take their regular bus to school with all the gear they need. **PLEASE DO NOT ARRIVE BEFORE 8:45 AM.** The bus will leave for Mt. Misery at approximately 9:15 from Carusi.
- Students need a **bag lunch** (no glass bottles or lunch boxes, please.) Everything must be disposable and carried with them in their **backpack**. Do not pack the lunch in a suitcase! Your child will be quite grumpy without lunch on the first day. No other food, candy or gum is allowed.
- **Drop-off** works like this: Drive in Carusi's front entrance and bear left, around to the back of the building. A district truck will be waiting out back to transport all luggage. Please stay in the right lane until unloaded, then pull to the left and out. If you would like to stay and see your child off, park around the corner in the parking lot and walk back to the cafeteria. Of course, hugs and kisses are permitted, no matter what your child says!
